Crassostrea virginica (and other species)

- Feed by filtering sediments from the water with specially adapted gills.
- Can enclose water in their shells, which allows them to survive under cold and dry conditions.
- Secrete a cement-like substance to anchor themselves to a surface.
- Many change sex during their life cycles; individuals one year old or less are typically male, while individuals older than one year are usually female.
