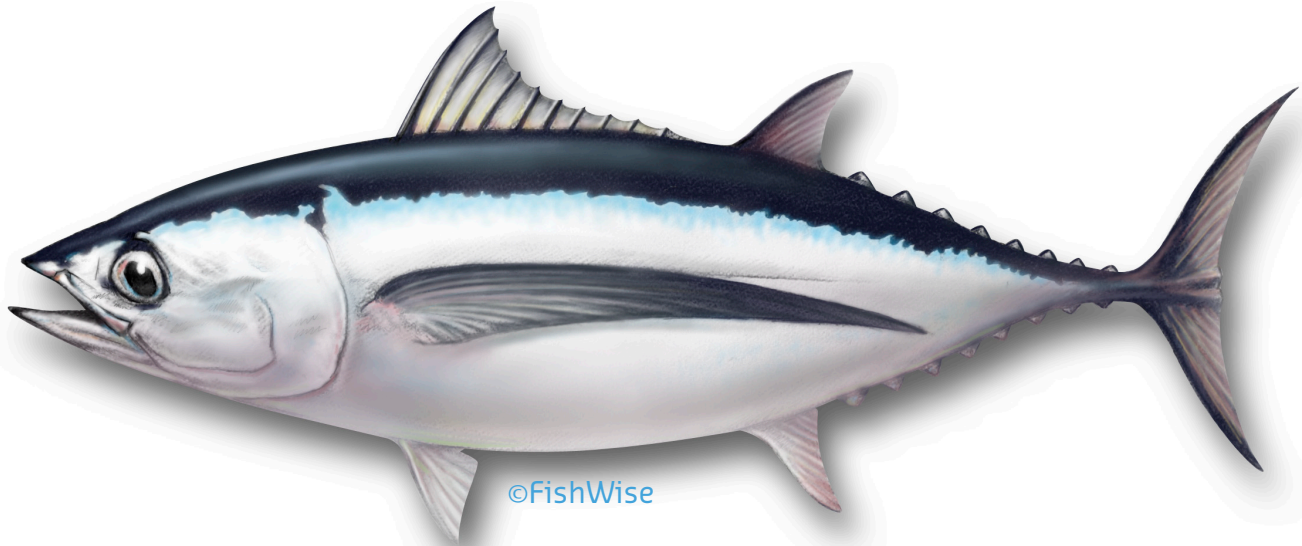

Albacore Tuna

Thunnus alalunga

- The only type of tuna that can legally be marketed as “white meat tuna” in the U.S.
- After spawning, eggs hatch within 24 to 28 hours of fertilization.
- Cannot be filleted because it has an unusual bone structure and its meat has a very soft consistency. Fresh or frozen albacore is only available as “loins” or “steaks”.
